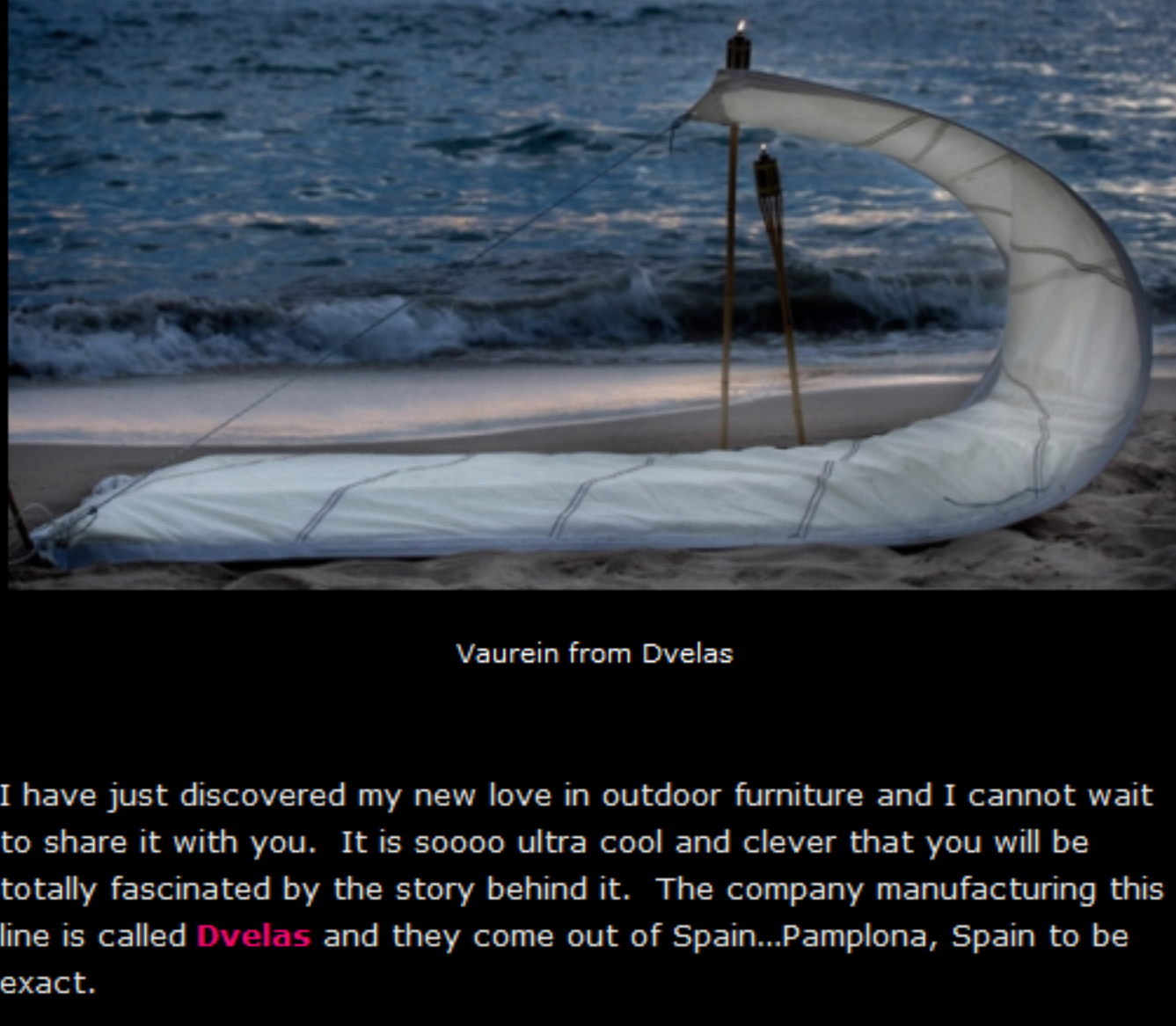
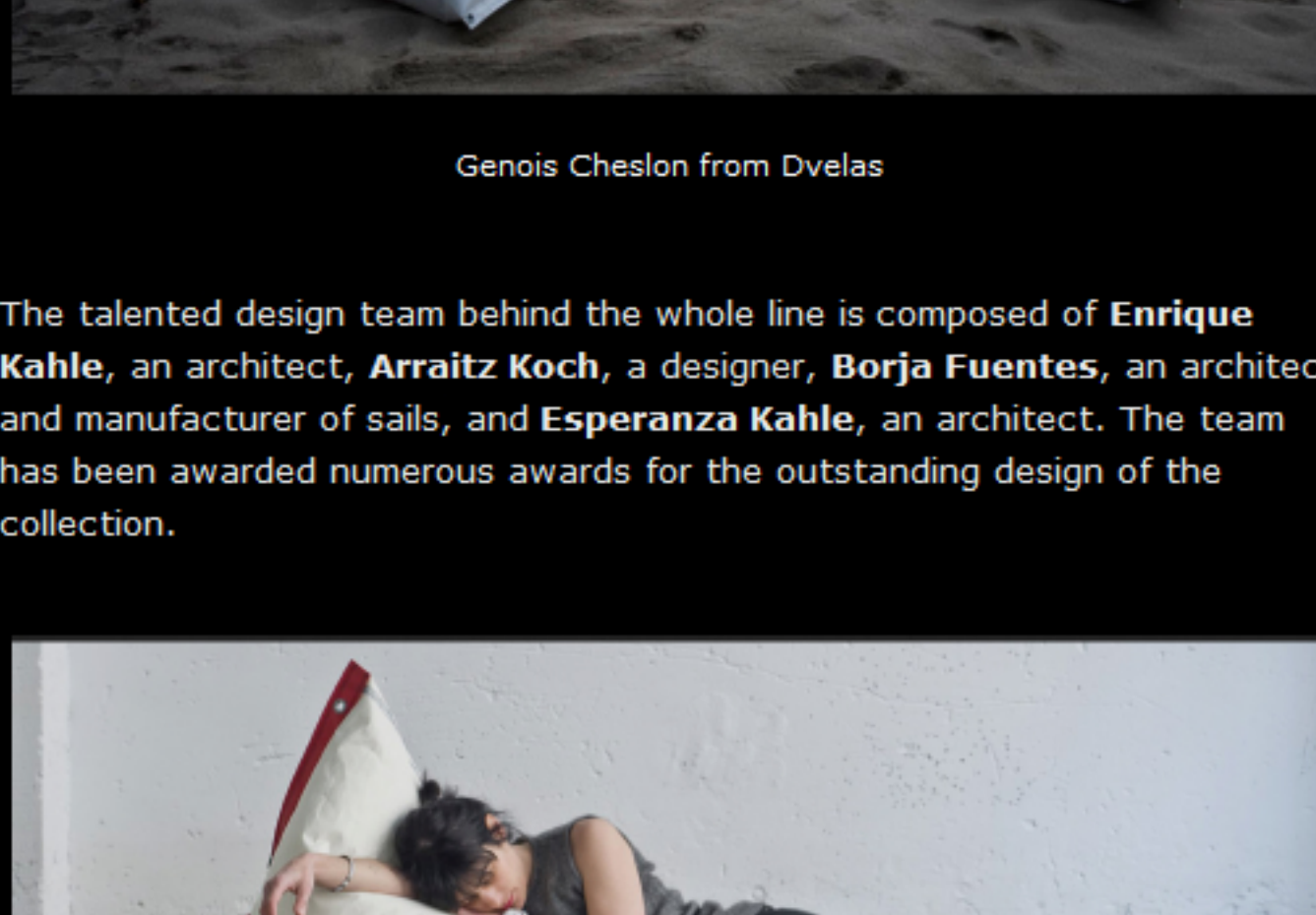


DVELAS "LIVING SAILS": RECYCLING SAILS FOR OUTDOOR FURNITURE



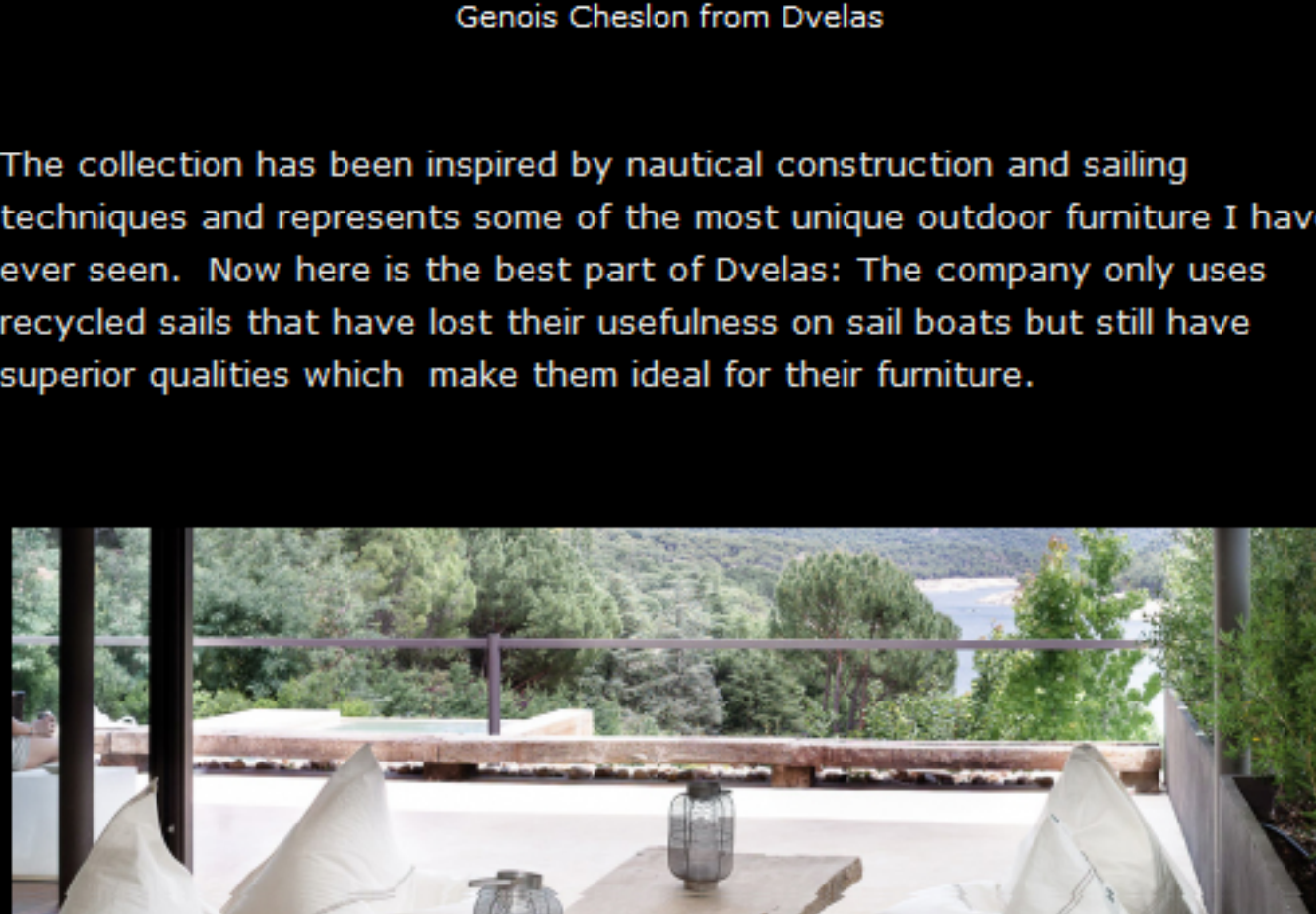

The collection has been inspired by nautical construction and sailing techniques and represents some of the most unique outdoor furniture I have ever seen. Now here is the best part of Dvelas: The company only uses recycled sails that have lost their usefulness on sail boats but still have superior qualities which make them ideal for their furniture.

In addition, Dvelas openly solicits people to donate old sails...even torn ones or particularly sails with unique marks or in color. Then they recondition all of the various materials and turn them into stunning furniture to put around your garden or pool or beachfront.



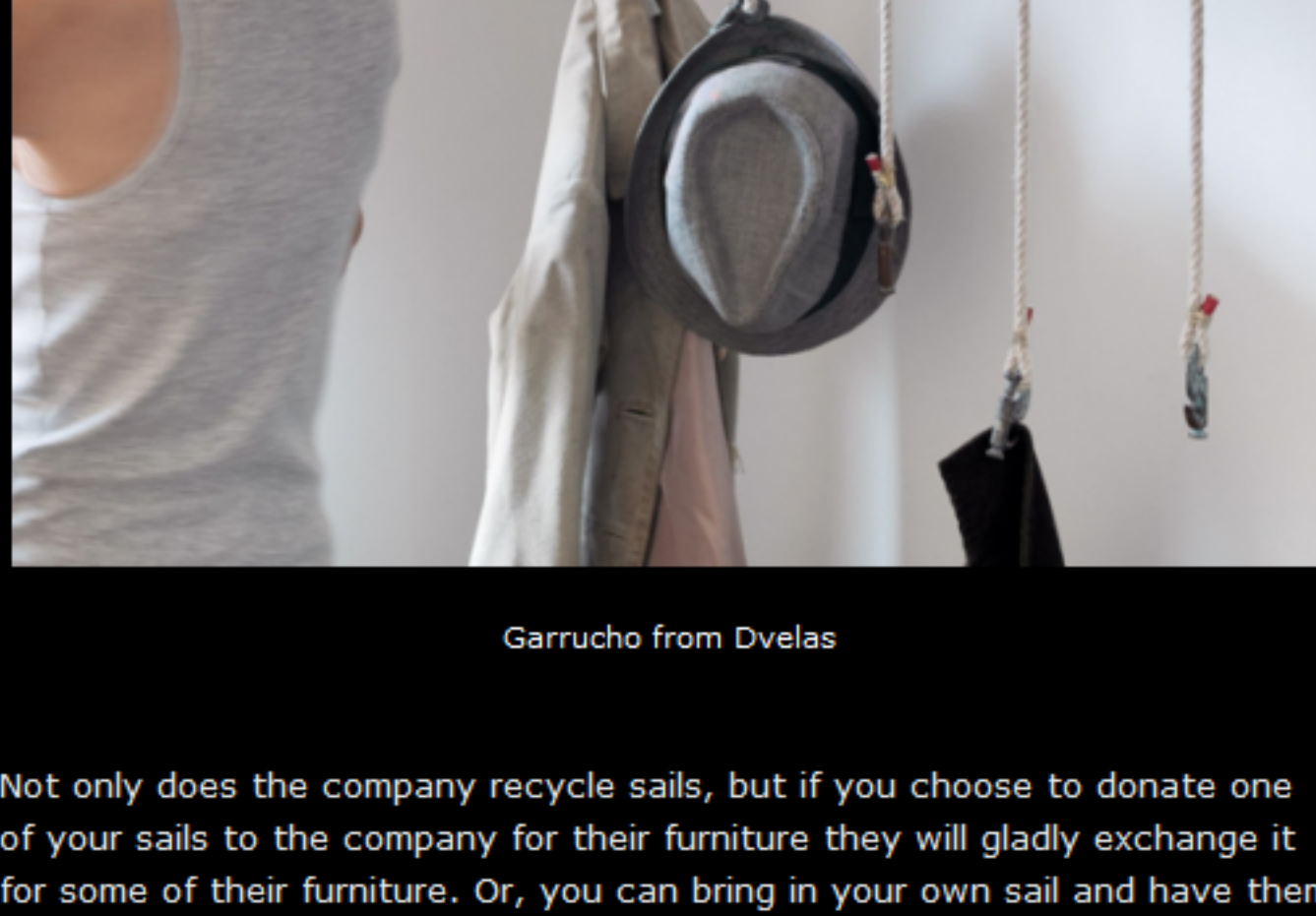

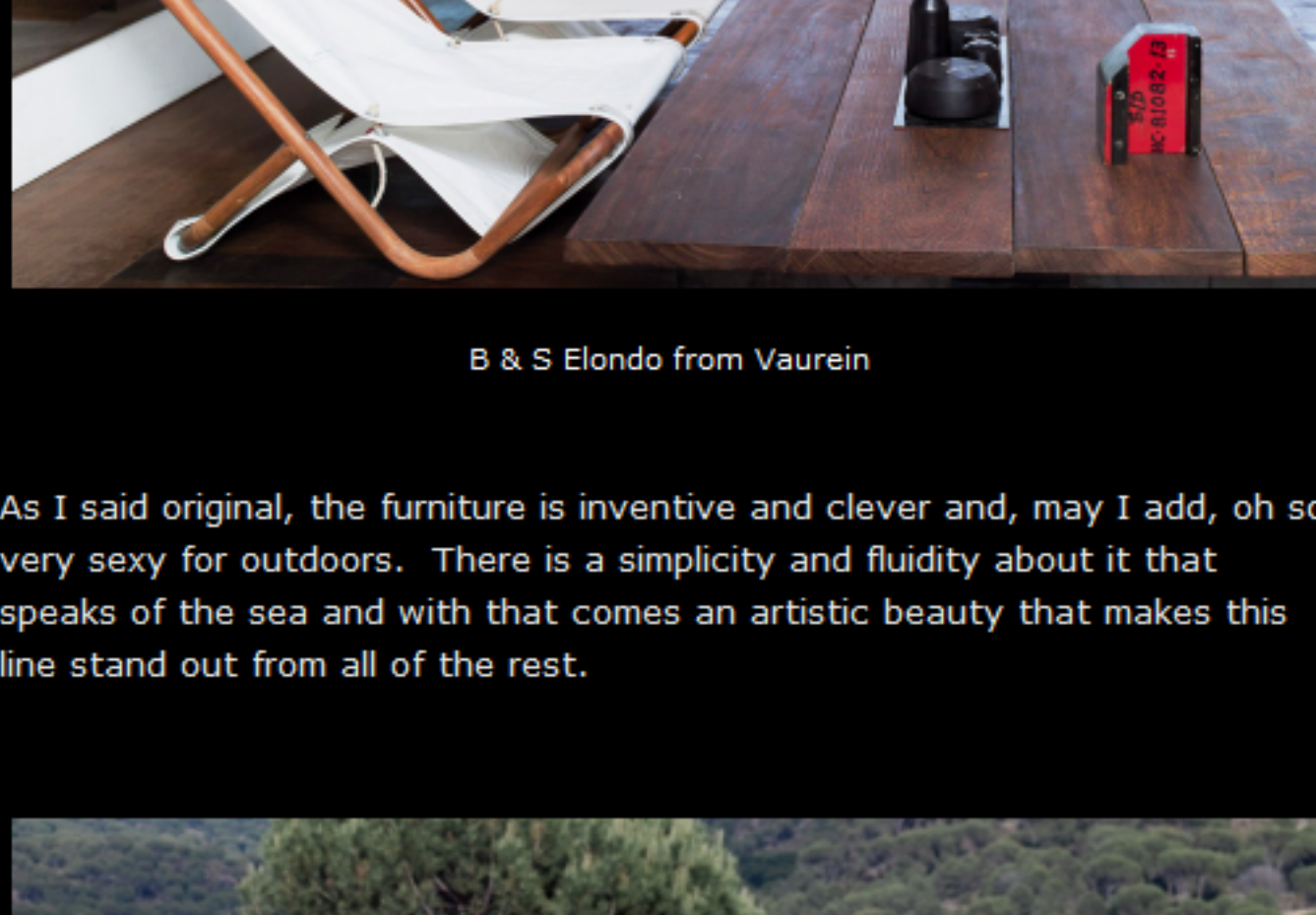
Trimmer Chairs from Dvelas

They also have a series of pieces that are what they call "exclusive editions" that are constructed out of special sails that have certain plastic sections which make their usage as furniture very original.



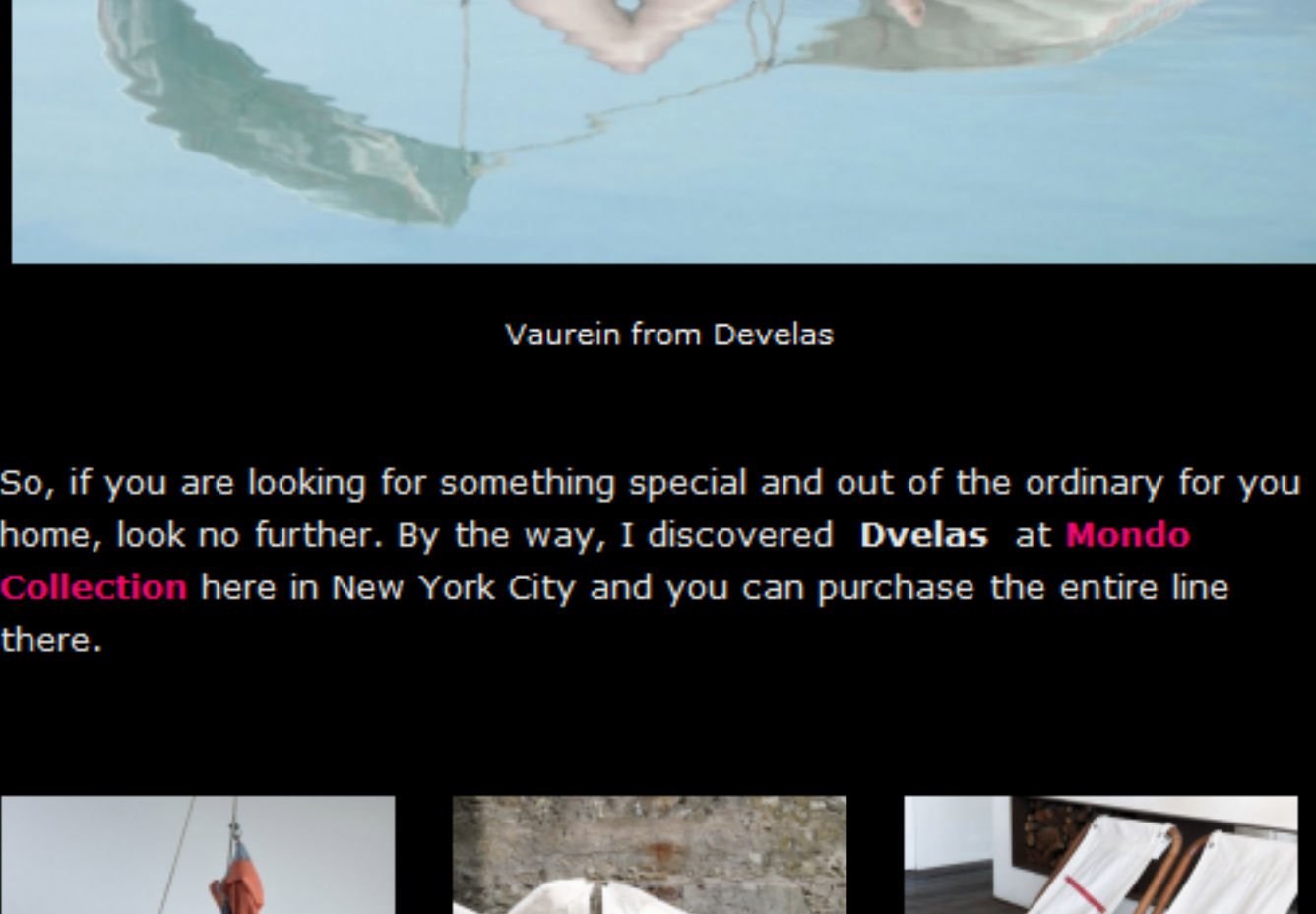

There is also a line of accessories that would be terrific additions to any vacation house or a children's rooms.



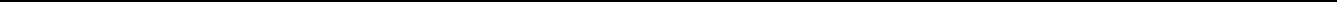
